A Treasure of Old Testament Wisdom

The Old Testament is a treasure of history and prophecy, all of which points forward to that day when the Word of God Himself appeared in the flesh to speak directly to mankind.

The Old Testament describes God's creation of the world, declares His sovereignty, and documents His interaction with the human race from the creation of the first man and woman through the accounts of each individual that God appointed to communicate His messages to various target audiences over many centuries of human history.

While there is much wisdom encompassed within the 610,000 words in the Old Testament, most of it is revealed through illustrative case histories rather than by direct statements of declarative instructions and declarations of universal truth.

Other than the Ten Commandments, most of the other "commandments," "statutes," "ordinances," "laws," and "decrees" that the prophets declared as God's spokesmen were clearly intended for very specific target audiences and for very specific times, places, and circumstances.

Following is a representative selection of Old Testament verses that are featured in the book, *The Most Essential Truth in the Bible*.

1 Genesis

- ^{1:1} In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.
- 1:27 God *also* created mankind⁺ in His *own* image ... He created them *as* male and female.
- 2:2 On the seventh day, God ended His work that He had made, and He rested on the seventh day from all His work that He had made.
- ^{2:7} When the Lord formed man *from* the dust of the ground, *He* breathed the breath of life into his nostrils and man became a living soul.
- ^{2:15-17} The Lord put man into the Garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it. ¹⁶ And He commanded the man, saying: Of every tree in the garden you may freely eat, ¹⁷ but from the tree of the know-

- ledge of good and evil, you shall not eat. For in the day that you eat of it, you will surely die.
- ^{2:18}The Lord God said: *It is* not good that a man should be alone. I will make a help meet for him.
- ^{2:24} Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother and be joined⁺ to his wife and they shall be one flesh.
- 3:1-5 Now the serpent was more subtle than any beast of the field that the Lord God had made, and he said to the woman: Has God said you shall not eat of every tree of the garden? ² The woman said to the serpent: We may eat from the fruit of the trees of the garden, ³ except from the fruit of the tree in the midst of the garden, *for* God said: You shall not eat from it nor shall you touch it, or else you will die.



⁴ The serpent said to the woman: You will not die, ⁵ for God knows that in the day that you eat from it, your eyes will be opened and youyourselves will be like gods, knowing good and evil.

^{3:6-7}Therefore, when the woman saw that the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eyes and desired to make one wise, she took *some* of the fruit and ate and gave it to her husband with her and he ate;⁷ and their eyes were opened and they knew that they were naked. So they knit + fig leaves together and made aprons to cover themselves.

3:8-13 When Adam and his wife heard the voice of the Lord God walking in the garden, they hid themselves from His presence ... 11 God said: Have you disobeyed me and eaten from the tree that I commanded that you should not eat? ¹² Adam said: The woman that you gave me, gave me fruit from the tree and I did eat. 13 The Lord God said to the woman: What have you done? The woman said: The serpent beguiled me and I did eat.

3:16-17 The Lord said to the woman: Because you have done this, I will greatly multiply your sorrow in your conception. In sorrow you shall bring forth children and your desireshall be to your husband and he shall rule over you. 17 Then to Adam He said: Because you have listened⁺ to the voice of your wife and have eaten from the tree that I commanded you saying: You shall not eat from it, cursed is the ground for your sake. In sorrow shall you eat *from* it all the days of your life.

3:23 Therefore the Lord banished+ mankind⁺ out of the garden of Eden ...

6:5-7 Later, when God saw all the wickedness on the earth ... ⁶ He regretted⁺ that He had made mankind⁺ ... all the rebellion grieved Him ... 7 and the Lord said, I will destroy mankind+ from the face of the earth.

6:8 However, one righteous man, Noah,

found grace in the eyes of the Lord ... and God saved Noah and his family ...

9:1 God blessed Noah and his sons and said to them: Be fruitful and multiply and replenish the earth.

17:2-21 Later still, God said to another righteous man, Abraham: I will make my covenant between me and you and will multiply you exceedingly.

⁴ My covenant is with you and you shall

be a father of many nations.

⁷ I will establish my covenant between me and you and your descendants + after you for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and to your descendants after you.

^{18:18}Abraham will surely become a great and mighty nation and all the nations of the earth will be blessed through him.

^{21:5} Abraham was a hundred years old when his son Isaac was born.

^{22:18}In your descendants, ⁺ all nations of the earth will be blessed because you have obeyed my voice.

^{24:1-4}When Abraham was old ... ² he said to his eldest servant ... 4 go to my country, to my kindred, and take a wife for my son Isaac.
